## Victim:

1. Academics - review report card/interim report, discuss academic and classroom progress with teachers.
2. Attendance - check daily/period attendance and tardiness.
3. Remediation - sessions held with counselor/mentor/service provider (CST, behavior specialist).
4. Behavior - review Infinite Campus incidents.
5. Nurse's office - check in for frequency of visits.

## Aggressor:

1. Academics - review report card/interim report, discuss academic and classroom progress with teachers.
2. Attendance - check daily/period attendance and tardiness.
3. Remediation - sessions held with counselor/mentor/service provider (CST, behavior specialist).
4. Behavior - review Infinite Campus incidents, especially post-HIB investigation.

## School-wide:

1. Check topic of HIB is addressed in school wide climate programs.
2. Include outside resources information, if necessary.

# School Self-Assessments

4. Curriculum and Instruction on HIB & Related Information and Skills
5. HIB Personnel
6. School- Level HIB Incident Reporting Procedure
7. HIB Investigation Procedure
8. HIB Reporting

# Submitting the Data

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- The overall grade for each school is reported as the sum of the subtotals of the 8 core elements compared to the sum of the maximum **score of 78**.
- Principal submits all ratings and final score to NJDOE
- NJDOE calculates the average of total scores from all schools in district.



# Next Steps

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- Submission of Statement of Assurances and School Self Assessment to NJDOE (2021-2022) through NJ Homeroom by January 31, 2023.
- ✓ **2020 – 2021 = reported to NJDOE 75 out of 78 total points.**
- ✓ **2021 - 2022 = reported to NJDOE 75 out of 78 total points.**
